O2 BURST PIPELINE - UPDATE

22H00

The larger part of the supply system that was affected by the O2 pipeline burst has recovered as was expected.

There are however, certain areas within the City of Ekurhuleni Metropolitan Municipality that are struggling to either recover or to maintain a consistent water supply.

In order to address this we will be immediately implementing a 50-percent reduction to specific areas in that Metro to allow for the complete restoration of supply to all consumers.

This intervention is scheduled to be completed by 04h00 tomorrow morning.

Below are the meters identified, and in brackets are the areas that will be impacted,

1. Boundary East (Isando Industrial areas and Isando Reservoir, Kempton Park Ext, Bredell and Kempton Park CBD).
2. Boundary West (Isando Industrial areas and Isando Reservoir).
3. Barbara (Elandsfontein area)
4. Northridge (Kempton Park)
5. West Reservoir (Kempton Park area, Birchleigh and Van Riebeeck Park)
6. Barbara Meter (Elandsfontein area)

7. Spartan Meter (Ester Park, Van Riebeeck Park, Sebenza and Terenure).
