



## **CALL FOR PROPOSALS: NGOs FUNDING**

Rand Water Foundation is a vehicle through which Rand Water fulfills its commitment to helping Government in achieving its vision of a better life for all, by promoting job creation, skills transfer, enterprise development, community capacity building, and poverty eradication among communities. The Foundation is mandated to: promote and support the delivery of water related services to communities in the areas falling within Rand Water's area of supply; coordinate, administer and manage Rand Water's Corporate Social Investment resources by undertaking community development projects in partnership with various donors and relevant stakeholders.

The Non-Governmental Organisations (NGOs) Funding is one of the projects implementing the strategy of Rand Water Foundation (RWF) through the NGOs Support Programme, one of the seven key focus areas of the Integrated Corporate Social Investment Strategy of the RWF. The project is aimed at allocating funds to NGOs that are operating within Rand Water's areas of Supply to contribute towards service delivery within communities.

Rand Water Foundation herewith invites qualifying NGOs for funding applications as follows: -

### **Project Deliverables:**

Successful applicants will be expected to undertake the following activities:

- Implementation of community development projects aiming at job creation and skills development targeting women, youth, children, elderly persons and people living with disability.
- The successful NGOs should be willing to transform into social entrepreneurs.
- The NGOs targeted should be rendering services aligned to the mandate of RWF within Gauteng, Mpumalanga, Free State and North West Provinces. Funding proposals should clearly outline the following:

- Budget breakdown, number of jobs to be created/sustained and total number of beneficiaries targeted;
- Proof of previous activities of such nature;
- Existing and potential partners supporting the project and their contributions

The following documentation should be attached to the proposals:

- Completed RWF application Form.
- Constitution of the organisation;
- Valid NGO registration certificate or proof of NPO registration;
- A letter from the Ward Councillor/traditional leader/sworn affidavits from police station confirming that indeed the NGO is rendering services to the community;
- Tax Clearance Certificate;
- Detailed Project plan;
- Stamped bank letter confirming the account details in the name of the organisation;
- Management account (Income and expenditure) statement;
- The NGO must be in operation at least for a year;
