The Foundation is on a journey to becoming a National Water Sanitation and Hygiene (WASH) Centre of Excellence ensuring Communities' access to clean and safe drinking water; Adequate and dignified sanitation facilities for vulnerable communities; Prevention of water sources contamination; and Promoting hands-washing for behavioral change on personal hygiene through; Business partnerships development for WASH, a socio-economic developmental model integrating water, sanitation and hygiene interventions through entrepreneurship and the NGOs' sector as service delivery partners. Key strategic impact analysis resonates in Clean drinking water; Sanitation and hygiene; Water quality; Water use efficiency; Water resources management; and Ecosystems. The project is aimed at creating an enabling environment for SMMEs already focusing on WASH business and those aspiring to focus on WASH and grow within the WASH sector through a comprehensive capacity building programme on WASH service delivery. Interested SMMEs based in Gauteng, Northwest, Mpumalanga and Free State are therefore invited to apply to participate in the RWF WASH Business Incubation Initiative for a period of one (01) to three (03) years, depending on the development needs of participant SMMEs.

- ✓ Must be in operation for at least one (01) year;
- ✓ A letter of good standing.
