Dear War on Leaks Trainees

**RE: War on leaks Project Training Plan for Water Conservation and Water Demand Management (WC/WDM)**

The second phase of the War on leaks project started on 10th August 2016 with the skills programme in Water Conservation and Water Demand Management.

The planned completion date for the skills programme is 30th November 2016. The following activities are scheduled for the month of November 2016:

- Completion of Training
- Re-assessment
- Finalisation of Portfolios of Evidence (PoEs)
- Internal moderation
- Submission of the Moderators' Report

We have established, through on-going monitoring and service provider reports, that training centres across the country will complete the skills programme on different dates in November. This has resulted in the decision that once the compulsory class attendance has been completed, only trainees that need to complete their PoEs and undergo reassessment will be expected in class. Trainees are not required to be in class during moderation.

While we have made the abovementioned decision, it remains the prerogative of the service provider to decide what happens with the trainees that have completed the skills programme.



All trainees must ensure that they have signed and submitted all the necessary documents including PoEs, certified copies of Identity Documents (IDs), cvs, learner agreements and qualifications as this impact on certification.

A communiqué will be sent via sms and the War on Leaks (WOL) website by 9th December 2016 detailing the next steps in the training programme. The training will start on 18th January 2017.

The information will include the full addresses of:

- The Apprenticeship/Artisan training institution each learner will report to and
- The venue to which each Water Agent must report.
