PLANNED MAINTENANCE ON THE R1, S1 AND R5 PIPELINES COMPLETE

Rand Water's 30-hour scheduled planned maintenance on its S1, R1 and R5 Pipelines has been completed without any hindrance. The planned maintenance was scheduled to tie-in a portion of the S4 pipeline to the existing S1, R1 and R5 pipelines. The implementation of the project commenced at 03:00am on the 24th of February 2023 until 09:00am on the 25th of February.

All the pipelines were recharged yesterday (Saturday) at 09:00 and pumping commenced immediately. Currently, the reservoirs that were affected are gradually filling. Some municipal customers in the City of Ekurhuleni, City of Tshwane and Thembisile Hani Local Municipality experienced water supply shortages during this period. Rand Water is pleased to report that all work has now been completed and all systems are pumping at full capacity. Rand Water does not have access to Municipal systems and as such cannot commit to recovery periods. Consumers are advised to contact their Municipalities for updates on full water supply recovery times.

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
